~ **EZ ROCK 97.3 fm** – 1994-2002 - Was first personality hired by Telemedia to help launch this radio station aimed at women 25–45 years. Became *first female* in Toronto to *host morning show*. Was entirely responsible for the pacing, content, and execution of the program. Also mid-day host. Highest rated announcer at the station for 8 years.

~ **CANADIAN LIVING MAGAZINE** – 1981-1992 *Creator, writer, host* of longest running syndicated feature in Canadian radio history, “Canadian Living”. -Heard by *1.1 million Canadians daily*, on over *120* radio stations nationwide – an unprecedented success story and one that has never been repeated in the industry.

-National spokesperson for Canadian Living Magazine, then Canada’s #1 family magazine, voicing all Radio and Television commercials for ten years.

~ **CKFM 99.9 fm** – 1980-1992 - In addition to on-air shifts, was responsible for writing short informational features and several two hour entertainment programs, including “NightMusic” and “Countdown Canada.” As mid-day host, became most popular CKFM personality and second most listened to announcer in Toronto.
